

# **RPC Highlight**

H.R. 1767 – Awning Safety Act Sponsored by Rep. Troy Balderson (OH-12), RPC Region 3

## **Bill Summary:**

This legislation would require the <u>Consumer Product Safety Commission</u> to establish consumer product safety standards for fixed and free-standing retractable awnings. These standards would be required to include information to protect against risk of death or serious injury associated with opening unexpectedly and striking a person while removing bungee tie-downs for the cover of the awning.

## **Policy Background:**

The Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) was established by the <u>Consumer Product Safety</u> <u>Act</u>, which was enacted in 1972. The CPSC was authorized to develop safety standards for consumer products to protect the public from unreasonable risk of injury or death.

### **Committee Action:**

This legislation received a markup and was reported favorably by voice vote from the House Energy and Commerce Committee on March 4, 2025. A link to the committee memo can be found <u>HERE</u>.

#### **Previous House Consideration:**

This legislation <u>passed</u> the House of Representatives during the 118<sup>th</sup> Congress by voice vote.
