

# **RPC Highlight**

<u>H.R. 3426</u> – *CASE* Act Sponsored by Rep. Jefferson Shreve (IN-06) RPC Region 9

## **Bill Summary:**

This legislation puts limits on new federal courthouse construction to prevent wasted space. Specifically, this legislation establishes courtroom sharing requirements for new construction and prohibits any addition to an existing federal courthouse unless all existing space is fully utilized.

## **Policy Background:**

In 2010, the Government Accountability Office <u>reported</u> that the 33 federal courthouses that were built between 2000 and 2010 were overbuilt by 3.56 million square feet. The GAO estimated that this additional space cost taxpayers \$835 million.

A recent GAO <u>study</u> estimated that changes made to the U.S. Courts' Design Guide in 2021 could increase federal courthouses' size by 6% and construction costs by 12%.
