H.R. 183 - *Law Enforcement Officer and Firefighter Recreation Pass Act*

Bill Summary:

This legislation would make the National Parks and Federal Recreation Lands Pass available to Law Enforcement Officers and Firefighters at no cost.

Policy Background:

The National Parks and Federal Recreation Lands Passes cover the cost of entrance fees, as well as standard amenity or day use fees, at lands managed by the National Parks Service (NPS), US Fish & Wildlife Service, Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Reclamation, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The Federal Lands and Recreation Enhancement Act already makes these passes available at no cost to members of the Armed Forces and their dependents.
